


Program Overview

Eligibility

- Earn undergraduate degree by August 1, 2026
- Be at least 18 but not yet 29 years of age as of August 1, 2026
- Criteria
 - Leadership
 - Intellect
 - Character

- Online application
- 3 letters of recommendation
- 2 essays
- College Transcript(s) (Official)
- Resume/CV
- Video Introduction (max 1 minute)





2 Essays

- Statement of Purpose and Leadership (750 words)
 - Your professional interest and goals
 - How this program helps you
 - Your contribution to the scholar's community
 - The ability to understand challenges and opportunities
 - Initiative to act, interpersonal skills
 - The character, values, and determination to overcome
- Current Affairs Essay (500 words)
 - Discuss current factors and trends of an issue in contemporary policy
 - Make a realistic recommendation to intervene and contribute to a more peaceful and prosperous future
