One-year Master's degrees from Tsinghua University

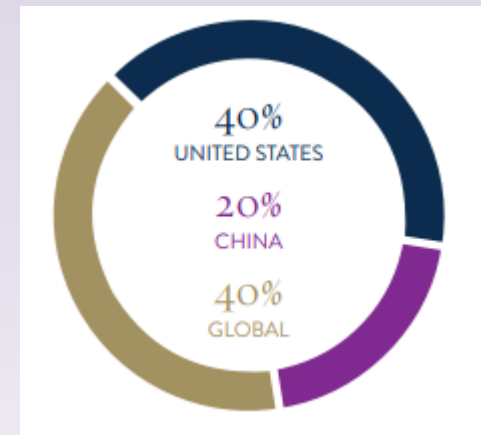

Eligibility

- Earn undergraduate degree by August 1 of their Schwarzman Scholars enrollment year.
- Be at least 18 but not yet 29 years of age as of August 1 of their Schwarzman Scholars Enrollment year
- Must be proficient in the English language

2 Essays

Leadership Essay (750 words)

Describe at least one distinct example that best illustrates your leadership.

Statement of Purpose (500 words)

Describe both your professional interests and goals and how the program connects with your professional trajectory.

3 References

- Recommenders should know you well and be able to speak to your intellectual abilities, personal characteristics, and demonstrated leadership using specific examples from their direct experience working with you.
- Family members or relatives cannot be selected as recommenders.
- Recommenders should follow the instructions in the Recommendation Request email to submit their letters.
- You can submit your application before all recommendation letters are received.

Selection Process

- Application Opens: April 13, 2022
- Application Deadline: September 20
