- Personal Statement (750 Words), Academic Programs, & Activity List
- 32 awards (2,300+ applicants, 953 endorsed)
  - 10-12 finalists in each of 16 districts
  - District 13 Colorado, Louisiana, Nebraska, New
     Mexico, North Dakota, South Dakota, Utah, Wyoming
  - Finalists Interview in Salt Lake City, UT



### Marshall Scholarship



- 38 Partnership Universities
- Some restricted program choices
- academic oriented, change agent in your field, contribution to US-UK relation
- Four essays in application personal statement, academic programs, leadership, & ambassadorial potential
- 3 recommendation letters 2 Academic & 1 Leadership
- Up to 50 awards (1,200 applicants)
  - Finalists interview in early November in Houston (Arkansas, Colorado, Louisiana, New Mexico, Oklahoma, Texas)
